**Commission Reports:**

**School Report:** Kathy Grinn was absent; her report was given by Father Anthony. The last day of school will be Friday June 3, 2016.

**Religious Education:** This report was given by Gina Baker. She states that over the last couple weeks there were 35 young people, who made their First Holy Communion. There were 8 from Saint Anne and 27 from Saint Charles.

Religious Education has concluded this week; with each parish's last class conclude with scripture reading, presentation of flowers to Mary and the Rosary.

Confirmation is scheduled for May 18 with Archbishop Vigneron presiding.

The last day of Children's Liturgy at Saint Anne for the summer will be May 22.

Graduation Masses for high school and college graduates will be held during the month of June; June 4 for Saint Anne and June 12 for Saint Charles. A cake will be served after mass at Saint Anne and a light brunch will be held after mass at Saint Charles.

A Family Retreat Day will be held at Saint Charles on June 5, led by Nicole Knudsen. She is still looking for volunteers to assist.

Vacation Bible School Registration will begin shortly for classes to hold at Saint Anne's from June 27 to 29. A bulletin notice has been published for a few weeks asking for volunteers but I only have 2 responses. I will need more volunteers, 8<sup>th</sup> grade –adult in order to proceed.

**Christian Services:** Saint Anne report was given by Carol Shaw. May 1 is the Chicken Dinner. It will be 11:30 to 3 pm or until sold out.

**Christian Services:** Saint Charles report was given by Sue Miller. She states that Christian Services will be furnishing lunch for the volunteers for Habitat for Humanity on June 7<sup>th</sup>, July 19 and August 9<sup>th</sup>.
