COMMISSION REPORTS:

Religious Education – Gina Baker

Religious Ed classes have been completed at both parishes. Classes will resume the week of September 21/22. Open registration is ongoing.

Sacraments are completed and will be recorded in the parish record.

St. Charles will be honoring high school and college graduates on June 7<sup>th</sup> at the 10:30 Mass with a light brunch following for immediate family members.

St. Anne is honoring high school and college graduates on Jun 14<sup>th</sup> at the 10:00 Mass.

St. Anne/St. Charles Vacation Bible School will be held from June 22<sup>nd</sup> – June 26<sup>th</sup>, 9:30 am to Noon – for students entering kindergarten through the 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Registration forms are located in the church. Will be requesting help from interested parents or those who need Confirmation service hours.

School Advisory Committee Members (2) will be attending festival meetings to assist with communication

School will start prior to Labor Day due to Labor Day falling late (on September 7<sup>th</sup>), and due to the change in Professional Development Days. Official start date will be in August – TBD.

Current enrollment for next year is 200 students. Pre-K is full with 4 students on a waiting list. Pre-School has 2 available openings. Only 7<sup>th</sup> grade is at suggested capacity.

## BUSINESS:

Council Membership – Al's term has been extended for one year, he will continue in his role as the President. Members at the meeting were asked if they agree to stay on the Council, according to terms. Each member not present will be asked if they want to stay on Council.

Bob brought up the conflict of our Council Meeting being on the same night of the Monroe Vicariate meetings. Council approved changing the nights of our meetings from the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month to the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month beginning on August 26<sup>th</sup>. The meeting will be held at St. Anne's.

## GOALS:

Bob worked on the Parish Goal 'Groups' that council had discussed, but stated the new groups did not make sense working together. Some discussion followed as to adding new goals as in focusing on faith building. Fr. reminded us we are a resource to our parishes. And asked what is the profile of both Parishes, as in traditions and demographics? Deacon spoke about faith formation being a goal for RCIA. He also stated that the recent Diocese survey showed results that ages 50+ basically answered the survey, and results for under age 50 were missing.

Bob will present a new goal grid at the next council meeting.

There was discussion if St. Charles wanted involvement with the Monroe County Fair. As this is a 'specific' goal, it will need to go before a committee for approval. To be discussed for next year. Deacon talked about Ministry Fairs where people can learn about church ministries. Bob suggested this be placed with a goal.

Questions were asked – how do goals pertain to mission statements, how do goals relate to Evangelization?

Meeting was adjourned with a prayer. Bob will do the prayer for the next meeting, to be held on June 17<sup>th</sup> at St. Charles.
