Minutes
September 20, 2017

Opening Prayer: The opening prayer was done by the parish council.

Business:

Proposed moving the Parish Council meeting time from 6:30pm to 7:00pm for future meetings this year in order to better accommodate council members' schedules. There were no objections and all agreed to move forward with the new meeting time of 7:00pm, effective October 25.

Discussed what commissions/committees need to report at the quarterly report dates and what material they need to be prepared to present. A representative from each committee should prepare about 5 minutes to share the highlights of the last quarter and what is upcoming for the next quarter. Committees that need to report from both St. Anne & St. Charles are the Building Committee, School Advisory, Finance Committee, Athletic Club, Worship Committee, Evangelization Committee, Christian Service, Vicariate rep, and Religious Education Office.

Approval of Minutes: Approved with revisions regarding when quarterly reports will take place.

Pastor's Report:

Fr. Anthony announced and brought up plans for moving forward with arrangements for people to attend the Beatification Mass for Fr. Solanus Casey on Saturday, November 18 at 4pm. Tickets are reserved for those who have inquired and we have enough people interested for inquiring about a bus to charter people to and from the event.

Father also went over the liturgical Schedule for the remainder of the year.

Confessions will be heard at St. Charles every Tuesday night at 6:30pm beginning in October.

Advent Confessions (in addition to regular Saturday afternoons at St. Anne & Tuesday evenings at St. Charles): December 5: Communal Penance Service 7pm.

November Holy Days Mass Schedule: November 1 (All Saints Day): 8:30 am at St. Charles and 7:00pm at St. Anne. November 2: (All Souls Day) 9:30am St. Anne and 7:00pm at St. Charles.

November 23 (Thanksgiving Day): 9:00am Mass St. Charles.

December Holy Days Mass Schedule: December 8 (Immaculate Conception): 9:30am St. Anne, 7:00pm at St. Charles, and a daytime Mass at St. Charles for School Kids; time TBD. December 23/24 (Sunday): 4th Sunday of Advent Masses - Dec. 23 4:30pm St. Anne, Dec 24 8am & 10am at St. Charles; *no Noon Mass*. Christmas Masses: December 24: St. Charles 4pm, St. Anne 6:30pm, St. Charles Midnight. December 25: 9am St. Charles and 11am St. Anne.

January 1 (Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God): 9am St. Charles, 11am St. Anne.

Remainder of meeting consisted of discussing the first 10 pages of the Archbishop's pastoral letter *Unleash the Gospel*. Main points discussed were: 1) the difference between the mission spirit that Archbishop talks about in the letter (the missionary nature of the Church) vs. being a mission church in the literal sense as far as merging and clustering of parishes is concerned. 2) the 'good habits' points of Apostolic Boldness, A spirit of cooperation, Confidence in God, and An attitude of gratitude.

October meeting will consist of quarterly reports and discussing the next section, the first two guideposts of *Unleash the Gospel*.

Closing prayer was led by Fr. Anthony.
