Funeral Fees

Music is integral to the funeral rites. It allows the community to express beliefs and feelings that words alone may fail to convey. It has the power to console and uplift the mourners and to strengthen the unity of the assembly in faith and love.

Here, at Saint Anne and Saint Charles, the expected fee for the musician is \$100. If a family requests additional musicians or a professional soloist, there are additional fees.

Other stipends/gifts made to the priest/presider and to Saint Anne or Saint Charles are greatly appreciated, but not required.

When a family makes all arrangements through a Funeral Home, stipends are often part of the total funeral cost, and therefore the fees/donations, designated by the family, are given to the church through the Funeral Director at the time of the Mass. Speak to your Funeral Director for clarification of any of the charges that you are billed.
